Twice As Good To Film "A Taste of New Mexico" Episode October 3-6, 2016

The Twice As Good Show will be filming "A Taste of New Mexico" at iconic locations across New Mexico from October 3 - 6, 2016.

<u>Twice as Good</u> is a cooking show for kids airing on PBS stations across the country featuring twin sisters Hadley and Delaney Robertson. *Twice As Good* encourages nutritious cooking and healthy eating and uses its recipes and ingredients as a platform to teach science, geography, math, history, and art. *Twice As Good* is distributed to the PBS community across the country by NETA (the National Educational Telecommunications Association) and produced and presented in association with New Hampshire Public Television.

In "A Taste of New Mexico" Hadley and Delaney will meet with Santa Fe Chef Michelle Chavez to prepare dishes inspired by famed New Mexico artist Georgia O'Keeffe. A visit to the Georgia O'Keeffe Museum and a chat with Margaret Wood, O'Keeffe's personal chef and author of "A Painter's Kitchen," are also planned, as are some of New Mexico's most distinctive sites: Pueblo de Taos, White Sands National Monument, Carlsbad Caverns National Park, and Bandelier National Monument. The episode is to be topped off by an excursion to 45th Annual Albuquerque International Balloon Fiesta, where Hadley and Delaney will take flight with a very special guest from Make-A-Wish® New Mexico. The episode will air in 2017 on PBS stations and will be available online thereafter on the show's website.

About Make-A-Wish: Make-A-Wish grants the wishes of children with life-threatening medical conditions to enrich the human experience with hope, strength and joy. Every 37 minutes Make-A-Wish grants the wish of a child. This is the second time *Twice As Good* has partnered with Make-A-Wish. In 2014, *Twice As Good* partnered with Make-A-Wish South Florida. Alicia Diaz, an eight-year-old from Miami, Florida suffering from Hypoplastic Right Heart Syndrome, cooked "Alicia's Perfect Cake" (an iodine free chocolate cake) on air with Hadley and Delaney prior to leaving for her fourth heart surgery at Boston Children's Hospital.
